## **Proposed Overseas Travel: Hon Poto Williams**

## Portfolio Disability Issues

On 8 August 2022, Cabinet:

- 1 **authorised** the absence of Hon Poto Williams from New Zealand, subject to leave from Parliament being secured, from 21 to 28 August 2022, to travel to:
  - 1.1 Geneva, Switzerland to attend the 27<sup>th</sup> session of the United Nations Committee on the Rights of Persons with Disabilities;
  - 1.2 Dublin, Ireland and Edinburgh, Scotland for bilateral discussions;
- 2 **agreed** that she be accompanied by one member of staff;
- **approved** the expenditure of up to \$55,249 for the travel expenses of the ministerial party as a charge to Vote: Internal Affairs (Members of the Executive Travel);
- 4 **noted** that she will also be accompanied by officials from Whaikaha Ministry of Disabled People, Ministry of Social Development, Ministry of Education, and Te Puna Aonui, whose costs will be met by their respective agencies;
- 5 **agreed** that in her absence:
  - 5.1 Hon Meka Whaitiri act as Minister of Conservation;
  - 5.2 Hon Peeni Henare act as Minister for Disability Issues from 21 to 26 August 2022;
  - 5.3 Hon Dr Ayesha Verrall act as Minister for Disability Issues from 27 to 28 August 2022.
